PXT 201

Advanced Extrication Course, 1 Day *Pricing Varies, Call for Details

Technician Level, Duration: 8 Hours

NOTE: (Pre-requisite for Technical Heavy Extrication)

Our most popular course, this 8 hour training session is emphasizes hands-on training with minimal time spent in the class room. After a brief introduction, students rotate through 4 practical work stations performing all necessary tasks on vehicles that are positioned on their side, and roof. Students are introduced and led through modern extrication practices using hydraulic and non-hydraulic rescue tools.

PXT 202

Advanced Extrication Course, 2 Day *Pricing Varies, Call for Details

Technician Level, Duration: 8 Hours NOTE: (Pre-requisite for Technical Heavy Extrication)

Our Advanced Extrication 1 Day course with a second day of lifting scenarios added. Students will learn how to utilize air-lifting bags, hydraulic rescue tools and mechanical jacks to lift vehicles to free entrapped victims. Vehicle lifting techniques will be addresses for vehicles resting on wheels, roof or side. Time and resources permitting, students finish the day putting it all together working simulated accident scenarios.

PXT 301

Technical Extrication Course, 2 Day *Price: \$525 Per Student

Technician Level, Duration: 16 Hours

The 16 hour course requires prior completion of our advanced extrication training or training from a recognized training provider. Teams of students led by a student team leader will attack and mitigate complex and heavy extrication scenarios. This scenario based course is designed for advanced students and will challenge them with problems that are difficult to replicate at their home training facilities. Students can expect to see scenarios involving large mass transit vehicles, cable guard rail systems, vehicles on sloping terrain, vehicles into collapsed structures, collapsed freeway props, vehicles wrapped around poles, and machinery entrapment.

PXT 401

Hybrid Safety for First Responders, 3 – 6 Hours *Price: Varies Depending on Class Size & Location. Call for Details.

This up-to-date training course provided by PXT and MGSTECH includes discussions about Hybrid part locations, High voltage hazards, power down procedures, Fire and submersion tactics and dispels all myths about these vehicles. The course also goes into depth on Airbag (SRS) Secondary Restraint Systems and alternative fuel vehicles (Hydrogen fuel cells and full electric systems) which are rapidly becoming more common on the roads. At least one Hybrid model attends each course and Firefighters get the opportunity to put their newly learned knowledge to use by performing power down procedures and other tactics on safely handling these complex vehicles. This course is a must for keeping first-responders abreast of changes involving response procedures for Hybrids and Alternative Fuel vehicles.
